

INDRA'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPOINTS CRISTINA RUIZ ORTEGA AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR IN CHARGE OF IT BUSINESS

- T&D business will report directly to the Chairman and CEO
- The new management structure implies the disappearance of the COO position

Madrid, 21 December 2017.- Indra's Board of Directors has appointed Cristina Ruiz Ortega as Executive Director of the Company. She will be responsible for the IT business reporting directly to the Chairman and CEO, Fernando Abril-Martorell.
