Pentesting is a defensive technique used by cybersecurity professionals to evaluate the security of systems and take measures so that attackers can not take advantage of them to steal data or gain control over them.

The didactic and gamification capabilities of the Minsait Cyber Range platform allowed the participants to learn these skills in a practical, entertaining way, fostering a sense of competition among them.

To achieve this goal, they were guided by an automated track system, so that when they got stuck when facing a challenge, they could ask the platform for instructions to continue with the challenge and, in this way, to 'learn by doing'.

Users only need a computer with a web browser to compete, saving them having to install complex tools on their computers. This contributes to the success of events and exercises.
