These guarantees include certification of compliance with the high level of the National Security Scheme, a contractual commitment to its customers to legally oppose requests for access to their data by any government where there exists a legal basis to do so, and the option for the company's customers to process and store data within the EU for Microsoft's core cloud services: Microsoft Azure, Microsoft 365 and Dynamics 365.

The combined capabilities of Minsait and Microsoft will accelerate the digital transformation and migration to the cloud of Spanish companies and public authorities via Microsoft's current cloud environment, as well as the new Data Center Cloud Region that the company is set to open in Spain shortly. This will feature the most advanced technologies for reducing the carbon footprint of Spanish customers and contribute to environmental sustainability.
